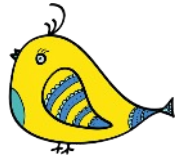




SONGBIRD WARM-UP GAME



How to play:

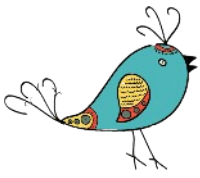
1. Cut the exercises out into individual strips.

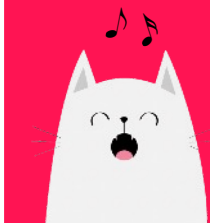

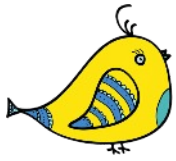

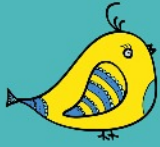


SING NEXT EXERCISE WITHOUT PIANO



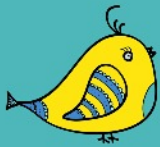

The blue bluebird blinks

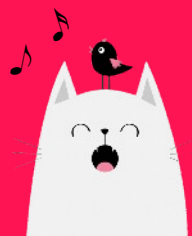


SING A TRIAD: DO - MI - SO

Four furious friends fought for the phone.

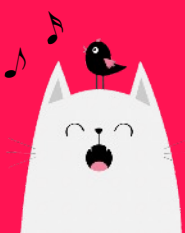
